



2018 ASEA Midnight Sun Chapter Elections Report

The ASEA Midnight Sun Chapter Election Committee scheduled and announced an election for the 2018-2019 terms of President, Treasurer, Secretary, 2 Member At-Large seats, and one Trustee (term 2018-2021). Mailed elections notice and nomination forms, a chapter nomination meeting (held 10-30-18), and the election (scheduled 11-15-18) were all properly noticed and carried out.

All nominee's qualifications to hold (or not hold) office were verified via data provided by ASEA Local52 headquarters. Only one nominee per position was qualified to hold office for the nominee placements documented below. The 11-15-18 MSC Election was cancelled on 11-07-18 via email because of the nominee information available at that time.

- MSC Bylaws: Article IV, Section 3: "To be eligible for office, a member must be in good standing for one year immediately preceding the election,..."
- AFSCME Constitution, Appendix D, Section 2, Paragraph F: "In any case where there is only one nominee for office, such nominee shall be declared elected."

In accordance with the above referenced ASEA governing documents, the 2018 MSC Elections Committee hereby declares the following elections results.

Stephanie Maltez was nominated for President, accepted said nomination, and is hereby elected President.

Gretchen Caudill was nominated for Treasurer, accepted said nomination, and is hereby elected Treasurer.

Mike Laiti was nominated for Member At-Large, accepted said nomination, and is hereby elected Member At-Large.

Robert Kinnard was nominated for Member At-Large, accepted said nomination, and is hereby elected Member At-Large.

Asha Hoke was nominated for 2018-2021 Trustee, accepted said nomination, and is hereby elected 2018-2021 Trustee.

- **SECRETARY:** A challenge was issued by Ms. Brianne Clark on 11-14-18 at 4:14pm, via email, for the Secretary position. Ms. Clark was nominated for the Secretary position, accepted said nomination, but was found ineligible to serve via “member in good standing for one year” information received from ASEA Local 52 HQ. Ms. Jennifer Chambers was also nominated for Secretary, accepted said nomination, and was found eligible to serve via “member in good standing for one year” information received from ASEA Local 52 HQ. This matter is now under investigation and further consideration. A determination will be made in the near future and/or may be referenced to the Statewide Eboard for a final decision.
