

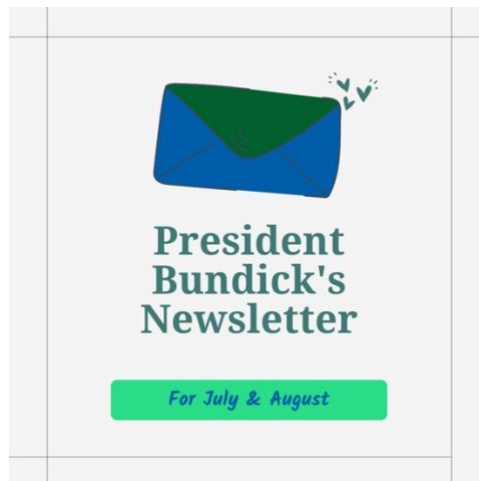

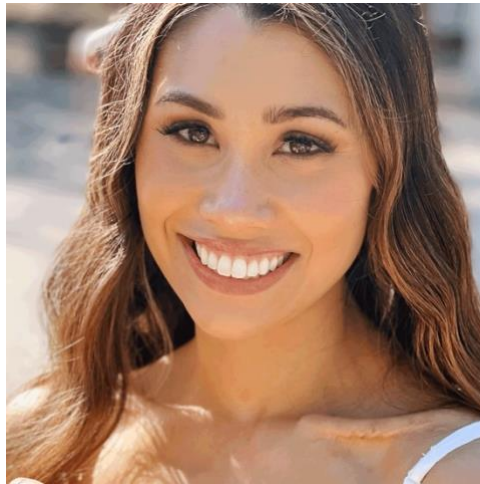

Over the past three years, the Juneau Chapter of ASEA/AFSCME/Local 52 has not been as active during the pandemic, and have found many opportunities to economize. Our membership comprises state workers who live and work in Juneau. At a recent Chapter membership meeting, Juneau Chapter Member Kelly Moore proposed that we make a meaningful investment by donating \$5,500 towards the renovation of the Glory Hall facility. Her proposal passed unanimously. These funds would support the Glory Hall's efforts in building an office for a new mental health clinician who would provide services to our Juneau neighbors that are without homes. Pursuant to that decision by the membership; President Paul R Kelly, Secretary Supanika Ordóñez, and Board Member John King presented a \$5,500 check on Friday, August 19.

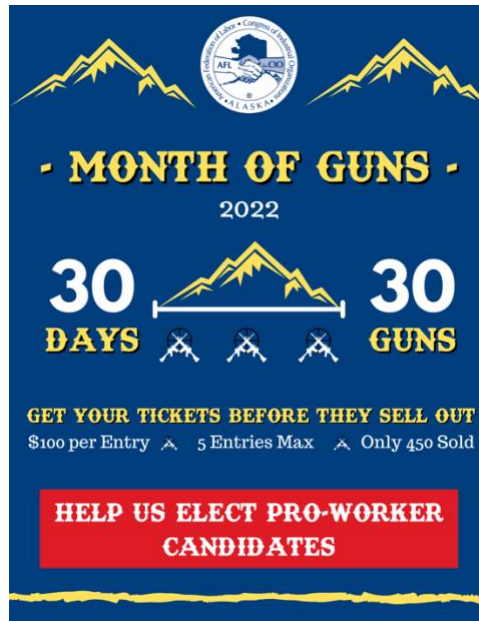
